### Panel Discussion: Attorney General Candidate Forum (10:00 – 11:15)

The Network will sponsor Hector Balderas (D) and Susan Riedel (R) in an Attorney General candidate forum to highlight their priorities for domestic and sexual violence. They will also respond to questions.

- Hector Balderas is finishing two terms as the NM State Auditor. He served as Bernalillo County Assistant District Attorney and then, 2004-2006, as State Representative, District 68 (Northeastern NM). Originally from Wagon Mound NM, he obtained his Bachelor's degree from NM Highlands University and his law degree from UNM. - Susan Riedel was Chief Deputy District Attorney in Las Cruces for 14 years. After an appointment as District Judge, she lost her election bid. Originally from Ohio, she graduated from the University of Cincinnati and obtained her law degree from Georgetown Law Center.
